

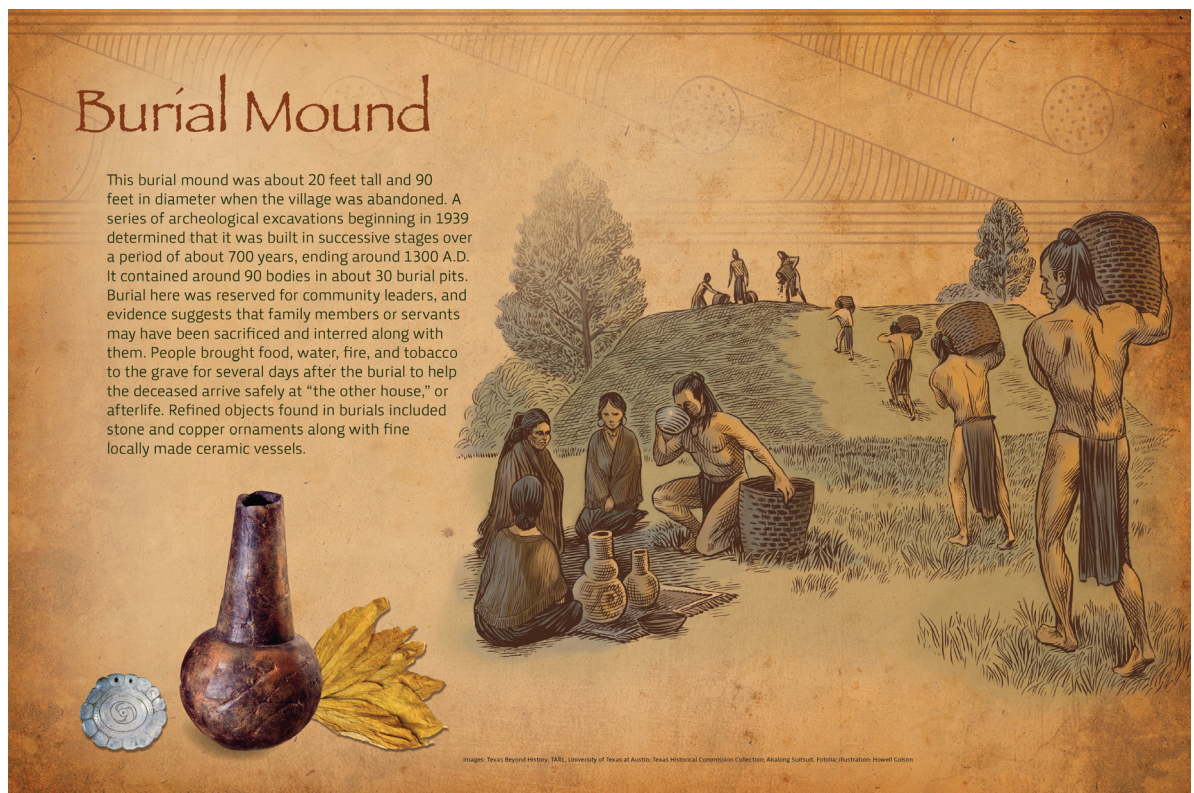

This site is but a portion of the sprawling Caddo village that existed here a hundred years before contact with Spanish explorers. They left behind their mysterious burial and temple mounds and the Caddo who live in Oklahoma consider the land sacred. We worked with the Texas Historical Commission to illustrate the aspects of the site in an accurate and sensitive manner. We learned about contemporary practitioners of Caddo arts such as pottery making and weaving, and used image examples of their work.
