As part of a 5-year master plan and implementation program, a changeable space was created in a renovated wing of the msueum. The challenge was to create a gallery for the major governing body of professional tennis that would double as a profit center for the events rental program. Since a bride-to-be may or may not be interested in tennis heritage, an important asepect of the program was relocating the exhibit cases and graphics. The solution was to develop a historically accurate panelled wall and use pivot hinges and stage door cuts to hide the graphics. All the cases were castered and one featured a vitrine that lowered into the base. This system has been successfully operational for ten years. this gallery is also set up to for video presentations and to cap off the design, an arts and crafts style chandelier was commissioned for this space.
