The Lamprey River is listed as a national Wild and Scenic Waterway and once was the site of over 100 mills from the colonial days until the 20th century. We developed an interpretive program for the National Register-listed Wiswall Falls Historic Site that contrasts the mill era, which once turned out a ton of paper a day, to its present role as a major brook trout fishing location. Our work included the design of a kiosk that acts as a entry marker to the new park.
